 Provided record funding for public education through the Biden-Harris administration. Opposes private school vouchers. Forgave over \$68 billion in student loans through the Biden-Harris administration. 	 Supports eliminating the Department of Education. Plans to codify a national private school vouchers program. Pledged to end the Public Service Loan Forgiveness program.
JOBS AND THE ECONOMY	
 Supports collective bargaining, your right to join a union and passing the PRO Act. Created more than 15 million jobs through the Biden-Harris administration. Biden-Harris provided record infrastructure investment, including in clean energy production. 	 Will install anti-worker, pro-corporate appointees to the National Labor Relations Board. Submitted consecutive budgets cutting Medicare and Social Security benefits for retired Americans. Promises a "drill, baby, drill" policy and reversals of current climate change goals.
HEALTHCARE	
 Took on Big Pharma and now Medicare can negotiate the prices of prescription drugs. Capped the price of insulin at \$35 and pledged to expand that price to all Americans. Passed the largest investment in the healthcare workforce in American history. 	 Will eliminate Medicare's ability to negotiate prescription drug prices. Tried to repeal the Affordable Care Act—which would have left 51 million Americans uninsured. Would allow insurance companies to deny coverage due to pre-existing conditions.
